



2015 Zinfandel – *Poizin Reserve* – Dry Creek Valley

Deep, dark plum in color, the bright nose exhibits mocha, raspberry and blackberries. The rich, supple, velvety, texture displays flavors of dried cranberries, blueberry jam, spicy strawberry, and red currants. The Petite Sirah in the blend contributes black pepper spice, balanced acidity and firm structure. This magical concoction was fearlessly guarded for nearly 20 months of aging in American and French Oak barrels. Share with a few of your closest “enemies,” or alone...
