



2019 Antidote White Wine

GROW+MAKE

Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Gris were harvested together from our Redwood Estate Vineyard on Old Redwood Highway. We also blended in Semillon from the Alexander Valley. The grapes were pressed into a stainless steel tank, where the juice fermented cold for 2 months. After fermentation the wine was barreled down into mostly neutral old barrels. We experimented with oak barrels made from Acacia Oak in France, to add round out the opulent flavors and textures. Drink chilled on its own or pair with your favorite cheese platters.

TASTE

The citrus and red apple aromas from the Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Gris match with the aromas of honey and pears from the Semillon. Refreshing on the palate, the wine is full of orange blossom and tangerine flavors. The finish is fruity, with a hint of residual sugar. The wine is ready to drink upon release, but will continue to age gracefully for the next 5 years.
